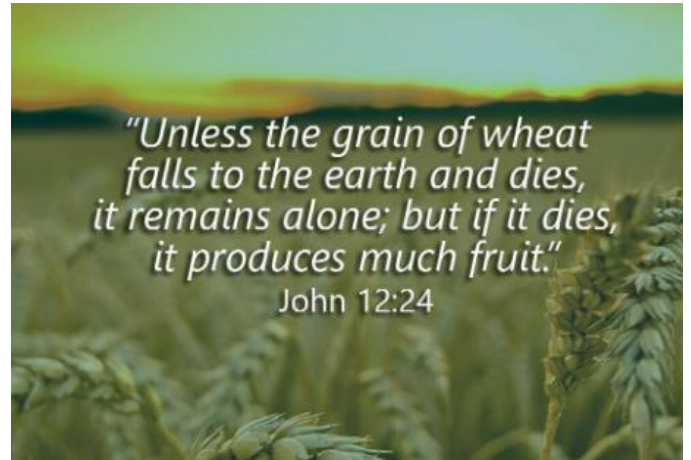

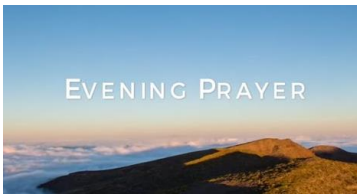

DONATIONS FOR GET ON THE BUS



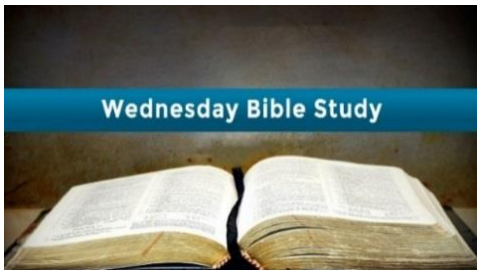
